Our comprehensive needs assessment is the systematic process designed to develop a detailed profile of the needs and available resources within the communities and target populations of Centre and Clearfield Counties. The majority of our funds are federal awards such as the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG), Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), Department of Energy Weatherization Assistance Program (DOE WAP), and U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
