
2019 ANNUAL REPORT



Community Action was initially established on November 14, 1965 and was incorporated as Central Pennsylvania Community Action, Inc. (CPCA) on December 14, 1967. The organization embarked on providing services to families and individuals with low to moderate incomes in Centre and Clearfield counties. Today, we have six outreach office locations: in Clearfield County—Clearfield, DuBois, Houtzdale; and Centre County— Aaronsburg, Bellefonte, and Philipsburg. With locations throughout the two counties, CPCA is able to provide our programs and services to the communities, families and individuals we support.

Who We Serve


The following data demonstrates characteristics of those served by Central Pennsylvania Community Action, Inc. in 2019 for whom demographic information was obtained.
